Dear Parents,

After considerable study and discussion, we are pleased to inform you that the iPads will be going home with students again this year. We are very excited about this opportunity and are committed to making this program effective and enriching for our students. Below, we have anticipated some commonly asked questions:

- 1. Will parents have to pay for the iPads?*
No, the District is fully funding the cost of the Fierke 1:1 iPad Program. There is no cost to parents.
- 2. What accessories will be provided with the iPad?*
Each student will receive an iPad, a protective case, a charging cable, and a power adapter. The iPad must be kept in the case at all times. The charging cable and power adapter should travel back and forth to school with the iPad.
- 3. Who owns these iPads - the students or the school? Will students be able to take the devices home?* The iPads are owned by CCSD 146. Students will be allowed to use these devices at home and at school, however, the iPad and all accessories must be returned at the end of the school year. Students are ultimately responsible for their iPad.
- 4. What happens if my child breaks or loses his/her iPad and/or accessories?*
The "Find My iPad" app will be loaded onto each device to help locate it in the event it is misplaced or stolen. Parents will be responsible for replacing any lost or stolen charging cables and/or power adapters, and will also be responsible for any loss or damage done to the iPad and/or case. Parents will be issued an invoice according to damages.
- 5. What if my family already owns an iPad?*
All students will be required to use the iPads issued by CCSD 146. School iPads will have certain applications, features, and restrictions that cannot be customized at home.
- 6. Will students be able to connect to other wireless networks with the iPad?*
Yes, however students will not be able to download any apps. The student is responsible for all pictures, downloads and content on their iPad. Please see the Acceptable Use Policy.
- 7. Can the student(s) use the iPad to access the internet at home?*
Yes. Parents should monitor usage to ensure it is appropriate and adhere to Student/Parent Handbook regulations.
- 8. Can families choose to opt out of the 1:1 iPad Program?*
No. The iPad is a curricular tool and utilization as a curricular tool will become a regular practice. The iPad is essential to student learning.

We have put a great deal of thought and research into this decision and are excited about the new learning opportunities it will provide for our students. Parent/Guardian iPad Agreement

District 146 will issue an iPad to your child as well as a power adapter, charging cable and protective case.
