Immunization Clinic



Clinic dates are walk-in. No appointment necessary! Please call for dates.

Vaccines are...

Vaccines can...

- * Save a child's life
- * Save your family time & money
- * Protect future generations

Immunization clinics are held monthly at the Orland Township office, where free vaccines are administered to residents 18 and under; some eligibility restrictions apply.

Vaccines for adults 19 and older are also available for a discounted fee!

*A parent or legal guardian must accompany a child unless special arrangements are made with the Health Services department prior to the clinic.

*Individuals who are receiving shots must eat before attending the clinic.

*Requirements:

- A written up-to-date immunization record for each child. Immunizations will not be given without an up-to-date immunization record.
- Medicaid card (if applicable)
- A parent's photo ID



Eligibility

- * Underinsured (private insurance does not cover vaccines)
- * Medicaid—eligible
- * Uninsured
- * Any child 18 and under is eligible to receive immunizations, regardless of residency
- * Eligible non-resident children may be immunized for \$20 per vaccine
- * Those with Medicaid or All Kids coverage are not required to pay the fee.
