Elements of Design

Skill:

- Identify and use intermediate colors: red-orange, red-violet, blue-violet, blue-green, yellow-orange, and yellow-green
- Identify and use warm and cool colors
- Compare and contrast organic and geometric shapes
- Use line and Line variation
- Identify and use foreground, middle ground, and background
- Discuss and examine various textures
- Identify and use three-dimensional forms: sphere, cylinder, cube, pyramid, and cone

Performance:

- Create a Color Wheel that shows primary, secondary and intermediate colors
